42. **Resolution No.2022-13:** A Resolution that its law enforcement personnel shall not use excessive  
43. force against any individuals engaged in nonviolent civil rights demonstrations; and Applicable  
44. State and local laws that prohibit physically barring entrance to or exit from a facility or location  
45. which is the subject of such nonviolent civil rights demonstrations within its jurisdiction, shall be  
46. enforced. **MSP: To approve Resolution No.2022-13 Councilor Officer/Bloom 5 Yay 1 Nay**

48. **Resolution No. 2022-15:** A resolution to let it be known to all persons of the City of Prairie City  
49. that discrimination in the sale, rental, lease, advertising of sale, rental or lease, financing of  
50. housing or land to be used for construction of housing, or in the provision of brokerage or rental  
51. services because of race, color, religion, sex, disability (physical or mental), familial status  
52. (children) or national origin is prohibited by Title VI 11 of the federal Fair Housing Amendments  
53. Act of 1988. It is the policy of the City of Prairie City to support the Fair Housing Amendments  
54. Act of 1988 and to implement a Fair Housing Program to ensure equal opportunity in housing for  
55. all persons regardless of race, color, religion, sex, disability (physical and mental), familial status  
56. (1. children, and 2. actual or perceived sexual orientation, gender identity or marital status or its  
57. members), or national origin. **MSP: To approve Resolution No.2022-15 Councilor**
