

**PUBLIC MEETING NOTICE**  
**CITY OF PRAIRIE CITY COUNCIL'S CONSIDERATION OF APPROVAL OF CERTAIN**  
**CLASS SPECIAL PROCUREMENTS AND EXEMPTIONS**

Notice is hereby given pursuant to ORS 279B.085 that the City of Prairie City ("City") City Council ("Council"), acting as City's local contract review board, may approve several classes of special procurements ("Special Procurements") and exemptions from otherwise applicable procurement procedures for public contracts ("Exemptions"), as part of the adoption of City's public contracting rules and procedures. The Council is expected to take final action concerning the Special Procurements and Exemptions at a public meeting at 6:00 PM on May 13, 2026, to be held at City's city hall located at 133 S. Bridge Street, Prairie City, Oregon 97869 ("City Hall")

The classes of Special Procurements expected to be approved by the Council consist of one or more of the following: (1) purchase of advertising contracts; (2) sale of advertising contracts; (3) equipment repair and overhaul; (4) purchase of used personal property; (5) information technology products and services; (6) internet and telecommunications systems – hardware and software; (7) internet and telecommunications services; (8) copyrighted and library materials; (9) requirements contracts; (10) purchases under federal contracts; (11) hazardous waste, material, and substances removal and cleanup; (12) insurance – employee benefit and other; (13) disposal of abandoned, seized, and/or non-owned property; (14) temporary contract extensions or renewals; (15) temporary use of City property; (16) sponsorship agreements; (17) concession agreements; (18) donated materials and/or services; (19) gasoline, diesel fuel, heating oil, lubricants, gravel, and asphalt; and (20) use of existing contractors (minor alteration, repair, or maintenance). In accordance with ORS 279B.400, OAR 137-047-0285, and OAR 137-047-0700, an affected person may protest the proposed Special Procurements and Exemptions no later than seven days after publication of this notice. The proposed Special Procurements, Exemptions, and draft findings in support of the Special Procurements and Exemptions are available at City
